## Bay Area Quilt Guild Scrap Exchange

The BAQG Scrap Exchange meets the 4th Thursday of odd-numbered months at 7.00 pm at Quakertown Quilts. It is open to all BAQG members.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use only good quality $100 \%$ cotton fabric and thread
2. Seams must be an accurate $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ - please measure your own blocks in stages and the completed blocks before turning in
3. If you choose to make more sets than the minimum required per instructions, each new set must be done in different fabrics, label additional pinned groups as \#2
4. No duplicates in a pinned group.
5. No IOUs.
6. Press blocks from the back first to make sure seam allowances are going the correct direction, then press the front to check for accuracy of points. Trim all threads and clip all nubs.
7. Pin blocks into groups according to instructions and label each pinned group with your name and phone number. Place labeled pinned groups in a large baggie and label the outside with your name, phone number and number of groups traded. Remember one pinned group per person goes to the Guild.
8. If you stitch blocks to trade together instead of pinning, please use only 2 or 3 large basting stitches. Do not STICK name labels to blocks, please use pins or basting stitch.

TERMINOLOGY: SET - all blocks from the same fabrics PINNED GROUPS - one block from each SET for maximum variety - no repeats

The number of SETS to make is different for each unit, so see next page. PINNED GROUPS TO TRADE: 26 pinned groups each consisting of (9) different $3^{\prime \prime}$ f. HST. (6) different $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ f. HST, (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cut light square, (5) different $2^{\prime \prime}$ cut dark squares, and (1) $2^{\prime \prime}$ cut light square. **(place all in a small baggie)
FABRICS: Civil War Reproductions (late 1800s) in REDS, BLUES and light TANS or
CREMES. Dusty shades of red or blue. No other color except red, blue or tan in the prints.
MEDIUM to dark Blues. Light TANS/Cremes tone on tone.
FABRICS NOT TO TRADE: No solids. No color on the creme/tans, just tone on tone. No Whites. No Brights.

Patriotic UNITS


UNITS traded are for making GLORY BOUND (a Bonnie Blue Pattern), but our sizes are smaller than the pattern suggests.

This will be a very scrappy quilt and you will make the blocks once the units are traded and returned to you. It's ok to repeat fabrics, especially the lights.

One Pinned Group:



3" $f$.
For 1 SET of 3" finished Half Square Triangles (26 units), pair one LIGHT(tan or creme) with one DARK (red or blue). Make 26-3" f. HST. Use $3^{\prime \prime}$ finished Half Square Triangle papers on a ROLL , THANGLES or cut $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Press to the DARK and clip nubs. **** REPEAT 9 times with different fabrics. $(9 \times 26=234)$

For 1 SET of $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ finished Half Square Triangles, pair one LIGHT and one DARK. Make 26-11/2" $f$. HST. by using $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ finished Half Square Triangle papers on a Roll, THANGLES or cut 2 3/8" squares. Press to the DARK and clip nubs. $\quad * \star \star * \star$ Repeat 6 times with different fabrics. $(6 \times 26=156)$


LIGHT - cut 3-31/2" strips, subcut 26-31/2" squares (all 26 squares can be the same or different but only 1 square will be in a pinned group)
DARKS - cut 2-2" strips, subcut 26-2" squares (actually need 1 1/2 strips) different DARKS (reds or blues). $(5 \times 26=130)$

LIGHT - cut 2-2" strips, subcut 26-2" squares

Once the units are traded, make the following blocks:


3" finished units



Border blocks


Corner blocks

6" f. blocks
