Bay Area Quilt Guild Scrap Exchange

General Instructions

- 1. Use only good quality 100% cotton fabric and thread. Pre-wash all fabric.
- 2. Seams much be an accurate 1/4" please measure your own blocks in stages and the completed blocks before turning in.
- 3. If you choose to make more sets than the minimum required per instructions, each new set must be done in different fabrics. label additional pinned groups as # 2.
- 4. No duplicates in a pinned groups unless stated in the instructions.
- 5. No IOU's.
- 6. Press blocks from the back first to make sure seam allowances are going the correct direction, then press the front to check for accuracy of points. Trim all threads and clip all nubs. Do NOT trim the block or square it up.
- 7. Pin blocks into groups according to instructions and label each pinned group with your name and phone number. Place labeled pinned groups in a large baggie and label the outside with your name, phone number and number or groups traded. Remember one pinned group per person goes to the

8. If you stitch blocks to trade together instead of pinning, please use only 2 or 3 large basting stitches. Do Not stick name labels to blocks, please use Blocks will be det meeting at the Circle of Squares pins or basting stitch.

TERMINOLOGY: SET - all blocks from the same fabrics

PINNED GROUP - one block from each SET for maximum variety - no repeats

BLOCK SIZE: 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.)

DUE DATE: September 15, 2015, Fabrics Etc box

NUMBER OF SETS: 2 sets of 16 blocks for 32 blocks

PINNED GROUPS TO TRADE: 16 pinned groups each consisting of 2

different blocks/colorways

FABRICS: BACKGROUND - White tone on tone, no other

color

PRINTS - bright, clear "modern" fabrics, variety of print, scale and texture, stripes, geometrics, etc. Nothing with white background. Each set uses 8 different PRINTS in a color family or close colors on the color wheel. Choose a different colorway for the 2nd set. Batiks are ok to use. It's ok to use prints with other colors but should "read" the color family.


FABRICS NOT TO USE: NO SOLIDS, no pastels. No Civil War prints or shirtings.

One pinned group:





Yardage needed for 1 SET (repeat twice):

White on white - 2 yards 8 different prints in a colorway - (1) - 21/2" strip of each

Instructions for 1 SET (16 blocks): repeat twice for a total of 32 blocks

All strips are cut from selvage to selvage (WOF).

Cut the following:

WHITE ON WHITE - Cut 8 - 4 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 4 1/2" squares, 16 - 2 1/2" \times 4 1/2" and 128 - 1 1/2" \times 4 1/2"

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips

Cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips


8 different Prints (same color family) - Cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip of each

Piecing order:

1. Make 4 different strip sets by sewing a WHITE 2 1/2" strip and a PRINT 2 1/2" strip. Press toward the print. Then subcut 16 - 2 1/2" segments.

make 4 with different prints
2 1/2" white
2 1/2" print

2. Next, sew a WHITE 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to each segment. Press toward the white rectangle. Blocks should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".




3. Make 4 different strip sets by sewing a WHITE 1 1/2" strip on both sides of a PRINT 2 1/2" strip. Press toward the print strip. Then subcut 16 - 2 1/2" segment from each strip set.

4. Next, sew a WHITE $11/2" \times 41/2"$ rectangle on both sides of the cut segments according to the diagram. Press toward the white rectangle. Each block measures $41/2" \times 41/2"$.



5. Sew blocks together by rows according to the diagram. Arrows indicate pressing directions. Make 16 - 12 1/2" unfinished (12" finished) blocks.



Pressing Tip: press block from the back first, to make sure the seams are going the correct direction, then press block from the front to check for accuracy. Be sure and clip loose threads for a clean block.
