# Bay Area Quilt Guild Scrap Exchange 

General Instructions

1. Use only good quality $100 \%$ cotton fabric and thread. Pre-wash all fabric.
2. Seams must be an accurate $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ - please measure your own blocks in stages and the completed blocks before turning in.
3. If you choose to make more sets than the minimum required per instructions, each new set must be done in different fabrics. Label eact additional pinned group as \#2.
4. No duplicates in a pinned group unless stated in the instructions.
5. No IOU's
6. Press blocks from the back first to make sure seam allowances are going the correct direction, then press the front to check for accura of points. Trim all threads and clip nubs. DO NOT trim block or square it up.
7. Pin blocks into groups according to instructions and label each pinned group with your name and phone number. Place labeled pinned group in a large baggie and label the outside with your name, phone number and number of pinned groups traded. Remember one pinned group per person goes to the Guild.
8. If you stitch blocks to trade together instead of pinning, please use only 2 or 3 large basting stitches. Do NOT stick name labels to bloc please use pins or basting stitch.

TERMINOLOGY: SET - all blocks from the same fabrics
PINNED GROUP - one block from each SET for maximun variety - no repeats

## STASH BUSTERS



> Fabric Needed for both sets totaled:
> BRIGHTS: 17 DIFFERENT $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ strips WHITE ON WHITE: $11 / 8$ yard

## Instructions for 1 SET of BLOCK A (16 blocks):

Cut the following:
BRIGHTS - Cut 13 different $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ strips WHITE ON WHITE - Cut 2-11/2" $\times 40^{\prime \prime}$ strips Cut 2-4 1/2" strips, subcut 32-11/2" $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Piecing Order:

1. Make 2 different strip sets each consisting of 4 different 2 1/2" BRIGHT strips. Press according to the arrows. Subcut 16-2 1/2" segments from each strip set for top and bottom rows.
2. Make 2 different strip sets by sewing 2 different 2 1/2" BRIGHT strips side by side. Press to one side. Subcut 16-21/2" segments from both strip sets for the middle row or sides.

3. Make one strip set by sewing WHITE $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, BRIGHT $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and WHITE $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Press toward the white strips. Subcut 16-2 1/2" segments.
Next, sew a WHITE $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom according to the diagram. Press to the white for 16 center blocks.

4. Next, sew segments from step 2 to both SIDES of the center square (press to the bright). Then sew segments from step 1 to the TOP and BOTTOM. Seams should be going in opposite directions for fine points.

Instructions for 1 SET of BLOCK B (16 blocks):
Cut the following:
BRIGHTS - Cut 4 different $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ strips
WHITE ON WHITE - Cut 2-4 1/2" strips, subcut $32-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments
Cut 2-8 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, subcut $32-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments

Piecing Order:

1. Make 2 different strip sets by sewing 2 different $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ BRIGHT strips side by side. Press to one side. Subcut 16-21/2" segments from both strip sets.

2. Sew different segments together for 16 4-Patch center squares.

3. Next, sew WHITE 2 1/2" $\times 4$ 1/2" to both SIDES of the center 4-patch. Press toward the white strip, then sew WHITE 2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the TOP and BOTTOM.
