Bay Area Quilt Guild Scrap Exchange

General Instructions:

- 1. Use only good quality 100% cotton fabric and thread. Pre-wash all fabric.
- 2. Seams must be an accurate $1/4^u$ please measure your own block in stages and the completed block before turning in.
- 3. If you choose to make more sets than the required per instructions, each new set must be done in different fabrics. Label additional pinned groups as # 2.
- 4. No duplicates in a pinned group unless stated in the instructions.
- 5. No IOUs.
- 6. Press block from the back first to make sure seam allowances are going the correct direction, then press the front to check for accuracy of points. Trim all threads and clip nubs. Do NOT trim the block or square it up.
- 7. Pin blocks into groups according to instructions and label each pinned group with your name and phone number and number of groups traded. Remember one pinned group per person goes to the Guild.
- 8. If you stitch blocks to trade together instead of pinning, please use only 2 or 3 large basting stitches. Do NOT stitch name labels to blocks...no sticky labels, please use pins or basting stitch.

Terminology: SET - all blocks from the same fabric
PINNED GROUP - one block from each SET for maximum variety - no repeats

BLOCK SIZE: 11" FINISHED (11 1/2" unfinished)



FABRICS: LIGHT - Muslin tone on tone , DARK - Bright tone on

tone or multicolor print, no white backgrounds

FABRICS NOT TO USE: NO TANS, OR muslin with a color, no bleached whites. No DARKS with a light background....choose something that when cut up will "read" the same print. No solids.

Yardage needed for 1 SET (12 blocks): Repeat 3 times with different fabrics for 3 SETS

LIGHT - 1 yard DARK - 1 yard One Pinned Group:







Instructions for 1 SET (12 blocks): repeat a total of 3 times for 36 blocks

1. Make 48 - 6" finished Half Square Triangles with ONE LIGHT and ONE DARK. Use 6" finished HST Papers on Roll or cut 6 7/8" individual squares.


If using PAPERS, roll out enough papers for 48 HSTs.
From LTGHT and DARK fabrics CUT 4 - 7 1/2" WOF st


From LIGHT and DARK fabrics, CUT 4 - 7 1/2" WOF strips. Place a light and dark fabric right sides together then pin paper on top. Shorten stitch length and stitch ON the dashed diagonal lines. Cut on solid lines, remove paper and press toward the dark fabric. Clip "nubs" for 48 - 6" f. HSTs (should mesaure 6 1/2" unf.)



If NOT using papers, from LIGHT and DARK fabrics, CUT 4 - 6 7/8" WOF strips of each. Subcut 24 - 6 7/8" squares of each. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of all LIGHT squares. Pair a light and dark fabric, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, press toward the dark, clip "nubs" for 48 - 6" f. HSTs

2. Next, make 12
Hourglass blocks by
sewing HSTs
together according
to the diagram.
Arrows indicate
pressing directions.







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make 12 - 12" f. (12 1/2"unf.)

3. Subcut 3-41/8" vertical and horizontal cuts according to the drawing. Keep each new little block in the same position but rotate little block twice (center is rotated once) according to the drawing, then sew block together by rows. Make 12-11" finished (111/2" unf.) blocks.
