

Bay Area Quilt Guild Scrap Exchange

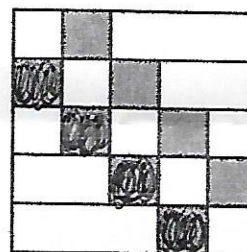
General Instructions:

1. Use only good quality 100% cotton fabric and thread. Pre-wash all fabric.
2. Seams must be an accurate 1/4" - please measure your own block in stages and the completed block before turning in.
3. If you choose to make more sets than the required per instructions, each new set must be done in different fabrics. Label additional pinned groups as # 2.
4. No duplicates in a pinned group unless stated in the instructions.
5. No IOUs.
6. Press block from the back first to make sure seam allowances are going the correct direction, then press the front to check for accuracy of points. Trim all threads and clip nubs. Do NOT trim the block or square it up.
7. Pin blocks into groups according to instructions and label each pinned group with your name and phone number and number of groups traded. Remember one pinned group per person goes to the Guild.
8. If you stitch blocks to trade together instead of pinning, please use only 2 or 3 large basting stitches. Do NOT stitch name labels to blocks...no sticky labels, please use pins or basting stitch.

STASH BUSTERS

- BLOCK SIZE:** 7 1/2" finished (8" unf.)

NUMBER OF SETS: 3 SETS of 20 blocks each
PINNED GROUPS TO TRADE: 20 pinned groups each consisting of 3 different blocks
FABRICS: **LIGHTS** - Low Volume - white or creme background with small print, small text prints are great, black or small amount of color is good. Avoid large prints. Each block uses 11 different **LIGHTS**, do not repeat a light in a block but the same lights can be used in the other sets with different brights.
BRIGHTS - each block uses 2 different brights, tone on tone or small amount of additional color. Good contrast next to low volume lights, avoid light yellow.
FABRICS NOT TO USE: NO SOLIDS. NO large prints for low volume, No tans for **LIGHTS**

Double Chains



7 1/2" finished

Inspired by "Scrap Basket Bounty" by Kim Brackett, p.57.

Yardage needed for 1 SET (20 blocks). Repeat for 3 SETS

LIGHTS - 11 different fabrics - 1 yard total (Fabrics can be repeated in all SETS)

Bright # 1 - 1/3 yard

Bright # 2 - 1/3 yard



Instructions for 1 SET (20 blocks) Repeat a total of 3 times with different Brights. The Lights can be repeated in sets but not in a block.

Cut the following: all strips are cut from selvage to selvage

LIGHTS - 11 different fabrics:

- 7 fabrics - Cut one 2" strip from each fabric
- 2 fabrics - Cut one 3 1/2" strip from each fabric
- 2 fabrics - Cut one 5" strip from each fabric

BRIGHT # 1 - Cut 4 - 2" strips

BRIGHT # 2 - Cut 4 - 2" strips

Piecing Order: Press all strip sets toward the BRIGHTS.

1. ROW 1: Sew a 2" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 2, and a 5" LIGHT side by side. Press toward the bright. Subcut 20 - 2" segments.

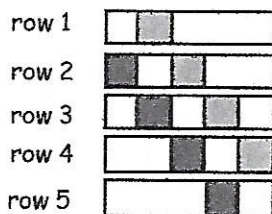
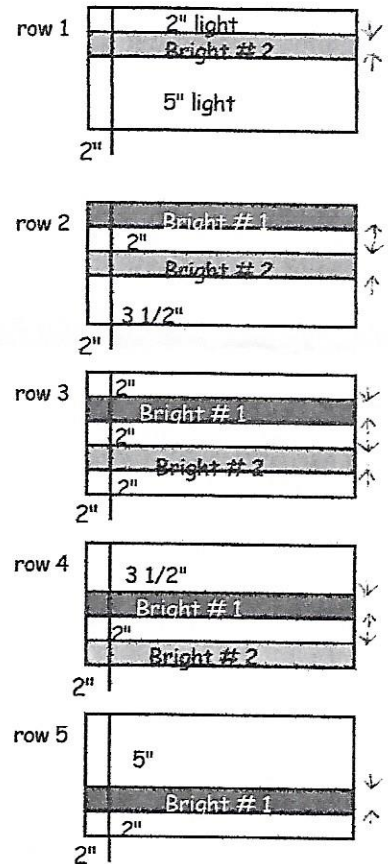
2. ROW 2: Sew BRIGHT # 1, a 2" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 2, and a 3 1/2" LIGHT. Subcut 20 - 2" segments

3. ROW 3: Sew a 2" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 1, a 2" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 2, and a 2" LIGHT. Subcut 20 - 2" segment

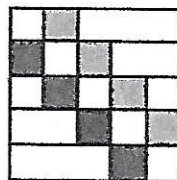
4. ROW 4: Sew a 3 1/2" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 1, a 2" LIGHT, and BRIGHT # 2. Subcut 20 - 2" segments

5. ROW 5: Sew a 5" LIGHT, BRIGHT # 1, and a 2" LIGHT. Subcut 20 - 2" segments.

6. Sew rows together in order according to the diagram: press to one side.
